## What we do:

- Provide culturally sensitive care in a safe environment.
- Provide education, support and care for girls, women, fathers and families regarding family planning care before and after Poopoop (Baby) arrives.
- Provide Antenatal & Postnatal Midwifery care.
- Labour & Birth support provided if required.
- Provide Breast feeding support and advice.
- Provide parenting supports
- Provide social supports.
- Assistance with referral and linking into other services as needed.
- Support with hospital visits
- Assistance with transport to and from appointments

## Who we care for

- Women & families planning to have a Poopoop- (Baby)
- Women & families who are having or just had a Poopoop- (Baby)
- Koori families—this also includes Grandparent, Single Mum's/Dad's or any other family combination who are caring for Poopoop -(Baby)
- Women & families not planning to have a Poopoop- (Baby)
